There are very few amenities in Potterton and certainly not enough to occupy the amount of people a development of this size will bring. Our main amenities are in Balmedie and there is no public transport to Balmedie. We have a Community Centre which is adequate for the residents in Potterton. Potterton's village shop is fully stocked with everything that you could need in a modern life. The Post Office in our village shop is adequate for our needs and is frequently used. We have a public bus which runs through the village every two hours. Unfortunately there are times when the bus doesn't come at all. Although the AWPR is near to Potterton there is no public transport from Potterton to Dyce and any where else. Children of primary school age attend Balmedie Primary school which is full at the moment and in a few years the school will be well over 100% in capacity. There is a nursery group run from the Community Centre for our pre-school children. We are a small self sufficient village and have everything we need.
