#### **OBJECTION TO LDP 2022**

## **ALEXANDER AND BURNETT PARK, BANCHORY**

#### INTRODUCTION

This Objection relates to the 'P' designations, and the settlement envelope boundary, which applies in the area of these two recreation areas to the west of Banchory.

The Proposed Plan says (Under P1) that the designation is to "protect the cricket and sports grounds as local amenities, and for their contribution towards the green-blue network and character". The allocation covers the Alexander Park, but it seems only the eastern part of Burnett Park. The wooded area to the west is cross-hatched, but it is not clear whether it is within P1 or P2.

The settlement envelope seems to follow the western boundary of Alexander Park, then comes back southwards down the Glassel Road, omitting both the tree lined core path on the west of the road, along with the large area of trees adjoining Burnett Park on its east. It then heads northwards in an arbitrary line through the park, towards the western edge of the curtilage of the Glen O Dee Hospital. In our view, all the above factors require adjustment, to provide the clarification and certainty which a local plan should provide.

#### **OBJECTION**

The Objection as regards the settlement envelope is that it seems arbitrary and omits a large wooded area adjoining the Burnett Park, which is well used in association with the park. A more logical boundary would be for the settlement envelope to continue northwards from the western boundary of Alexander Park, until it meets the old railway line. It would then proceed eastwards along the north side of the line, until it meets the Glen O Dee policies. All as shown on Plan 1 attached herewith.

This adjustment to the settlement envelope would also assist in resolving the ambiguity of whether the western portion of Burnett Park is protected by P1 or P2. At the moment it is not clear whether the black line (demarking the settlement envelope) is also the boundary between P1 and P2.

The attached plan shows a revised settlement envelope, with a clearer definition as between P1 and P2, and which we think is far more logical and defensible.


