Good Morning

We live at [REDACTED], situated directly across from Cluny Primary School.

Together with our neighbours, we have huge concerns about the speed of traffic on the road through Cluny. The 40 speed limit is frequently ignored at all times of the day and night and as such makes the road (and limited pavements) incredibly dangerous in such close proximity to a housing development and school. Our paramount concern is for the safety of our children (of which there are a number living here ranging from toddlers, primary and academy age kids) and the school kids.

We have received a notice regarding the proposed school path between Sauchen and Cluny which would be a very welcome addition however there is a real danger to walkers between Sauchen and Cluny if the traffic conditions continue. If the footfall increases when the path is complete we feel the danger is multiplied.

We would like to petition the council to act promptly to address our serious concerns. We note that other local village schools have traffic calming chicanes installed on their roads and this is the type of action we would like to push for.

To date our neighbour has contacted Councillor [REDACTED] who has advised she will raise the issue on our behalf.
