To whom it May concern,
I object to the proposed LDP based on:

CHAPS bid, FR120, was refused and one was that “The development would have an unacceptable impact upon landscape and inappropriate scale and siting. The development would contribute to significant urban sprawl within the greenbelt.”. The change in green belts for FR140/141 is no different and should be refused.
The above CHAP construction development in Potterton, West of B999 was not allowed as the road could not hand additional traffic. Therefore, how can an assessment of the unclassified roads support the proposed development. The road is already congested and is not fit for the volume of traffic this will produce nor provide suitable access for the vehicles and heavy equipment required to execute the building of the proposed development.. Therefore, the existing roads are not suitable to support this kind of development.
