To whom it May concern,
I object to the proposed LDP based on:

Barratt's document states "Scottish Water acknowledges that there is an issue with foul sewage capacity at the Balmedie Wastewater Treatment Works and are initiating a growth project to increase capacity for existing development and to accommodate new development within the catchment area. Upgrades to existing sewage infrastructure will be required and delivered." However, it is my understanding, based on feedback from Scottish Water, that there is no date set for the upgrade of the water growth project (805) which has been confirmed via SEPA. The Potterton burn is currently subject to sewage contamination to the sewage system not being fit.

Therefore, the planning should be refused as the water system is not fit for further expansion in the village.
