To whom it May concern,  
I object to the proposed LDP based on:

Previous LDP stated that Balmedie school was already full. There is no plan to extend the school as its current site does not allow it. There is no facility in the current plans to build a local school. One of the reasons the CHAP bid, FR120 was not allowed was that Balmedie school was at 120% capacity, this has not changed. Therefore, the nearest primary school or academy cannot support the new development and therefore it should not be allowed to go ahead. If the children are to be bussed to school this would increase the requirement for busses by at least 4 resulting in 6 busses in village at one time which would cause congestion. Therefore, the development should not be allowed as the current road infrastructure is not suitable for this level to transport.
