PROPOSED ABERDEENSHIRE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2020 RESPONSE FORM

As part of the production of the Local Development Plan, a 'Main Issues Report' was published in January 2019. The responses from these consultations have helped to inform the content of the Proposed Local Development Plan ("the Proposed Plan").

The Aberdeenshire Local Development Plan will direct decision-making on land-use planning issues and planning applications in Aberdeenshire for the 10-year period from 2021 to 2031. The Proposed Plan was agreed by Aberdeenshire Council in March 2020 as the settled view of the Council. However, the Proposed Plan will be subjected to an independent examination and is now open for public comment.

This is your opportunity to tell us if anything should be changed in the Proposed Plan, and why.

When writing a response to the Proposed Plan it is important to specifically state the modification(s) that you would wish to see to the Plan.

This is the only remaining opportunity to comment on the Proposed Plan. The reasons for any requested changes will be analysed and reported to Scottish Ministers. They will then appoint a person known as a Reporter to conduct a public examination of the Proposed Plan, focusing particularly on any unresolved issues and the changes sought.

Ministers expect representations (or responses) to be concise (no more than 2000 words) and accompanied by limited supporting documents. It is important to ensure that all of the information that you wish to be considered is submitted during this consultation period as there is no further opportunity to provide information, unless specifically asked.

Modification that you wish to see (please make specific reference to the section of the Proposed Plan you wish to see modified if possible, for example Section 9, paragraph E1.1):

Reinstate the OP1 housing allocation for 45 houses (Audit reference B/AB/H/012) in Aberchirder - pages 186 - 188 of Banff and Buchan Settlement Statements. Adjust housing allocations schedule accordingly

Reason for change:

It is considered important that a settlement of the size of Aberchirder has an identified housing allocation to assist in maintaining the viability of the community. The allocation was first entered into the housing land audit in 2014 in circumstances where an existing site was under construction by a local house builder. Demand in the settlement for housing does exist with a current development on a windfall site delivering 12 houses at the start of the plan period.

If it is considered appropriate to delete an allocation that has not delivered housing within six years of entering the audit then the principle should be applied consistently throughout the Rural Housing Market Area and new alternative allocations identified either in the RHMA or, if impossible due to marketability constraints, in the adjacent Aberdeen Housing Market Area where marketability constraints are not an issue.
