Reason for change:

I wish to support the comments and recommendations made by [REDACTED] in his recent submission for keeping the currently agreed Turriff Masterplan within the LDP 2021.

Over several years now [REDACTED] (as my architect) has been working with the Planning Dept. and has produced plans for the future development of Turriff. This resulted in the current agreed Master Plan and OP1 which covers ground owned by my sister and myself. There have been previous alterations to OP1 at the request of the Planning Dept. (e.g. Community facilities whereby a primary school and associated playing fields were removed from the Plan). Therefore we feel that any further alterations would be detrimental to current negotiations with developers, which have been ongoing for some time.

I hope that we may be able to proceed in promoting the future development of OP1 as shown on the latest Plan submitted by our architect, which clearly defines the future expansion of Turriff both for housing and commercial opportunities.
